Nominees must not have reached their 21st birthday at the time of nomination, must be currently registered with BSA and must have permanent residence within the boundaries of the Grand Lodge of New Jersey. There are no tenure or prerequisite award requirements. Supporting letters will not be reviewed. Multiple nomination forms do not provide additional help to the nominee. Self-nominations will not be considered. Posthumous nominations will not be considered. Each Council within the jurisdiction of the Grand Lodge of New Jersey is permitted to nominate one individual to receive this award.

The nomination process is confidential. To avoid possible disappointment, please do not advise the nominee in any way of your actions on their behalf.
