PPC BSA Climbing Instructor (CI) Training

What:

Highly skilled training to become or renew as a BSA qualified **PPC Climbing Instructor (CI)** in order to serve on our Council climbing or COPE program staff and deliver safe and exciting outdoor top-roped rock climbing and rappelling programs. You will learn the skills required to supervise and teach Scouts climbing fun in Ground School, to select and rig a rock climbing site, and to take Scouts climbing and rappelling on rock crags! Topics include: Ground School, Site Selection, Bolted and Natural Anchor System Rigging, and Emergency Procedures. **PPC qualification as a CI or CI Assistant depends on your performance during training, and on individual evaluations while on staff for two additional PPC climbing events after CI training (e.g., SLIC, COPE or PPC climbing sessions)**

(NOTE: Candidates from other Councils should verify that this program meets their Council's CI staff requirements.)

When, where:

One-day Outdoor Class: Sunday, April 13th, 2014, 8 a.m.- 6 p.m.

Meet at the COPE pavilion, Mt. Allamuchy Scout Reservation (MASR), 750 Waterloo Road, Stanhope, NJ 07874

Outdoor Weekend: April 25th-27th, 2014, Friday eve 6 p.m. - Sunday eve 6 p.m.

You must attend **both** sessions. All training is based at MASR. Meals and overnight cabin are included.

Prerequisites:

The goal of this program is to qualify leaders who already know the basics of climbing and rappelling. **We will not have time to teach basic how-to belay, climb & rappel in this class.** As a prerequisite, you will need basic climbing skills that you can get from a climbing gym, or by climbing with a qualified friend or instructor, or by participating in any of our open climbing events such as monthly Sunday SLIC. **The prerequisites are:**

1. BSA registered adult. (See <http://join.ppbsa.org/volunteer/> to register.) **Bring proof to class.**
2. Take BSA Climb On Safely (COS) training On-line. (<https://myscouting.scouting.org/>) **Bring proof to class.**
3. Current BSA Annual Health and Medical Record, including Part C. **Bring a copy to class.**
4. Minimum 21 years old (Other ages may participate with prior approval)
5. Competence in basic climbing skills as found in BSA Climbing merit badge requirements 5, 7-11 (<http://usscouts.org/usscouts/mb/mb133.asp>). Essentially, you need to accomplish 3 climbs, 3 rappels, belay a partner on 3 routes (climbing and rappelling), and be proficient at BSA **commands** and tying Figure-eight (on a bight and follow-through), grapevine (double fisherman) and webbing water knots.
6. Bring your own commercial or tied webbing climbing harness, and climbing helmet.
7. Bring any of the following: Leather palmed gloves; Two 5' to 8' lengths of 6 mm nylon climbing accessory cord for Prusik loops; Two 10' lengths of 1" nylon climbing webbing (breaking strength of at least 17.5kN) for slings; 2-4 locking carabiners (we recommend oval or D style aluminum screw-lock); A figure 8 rappel device, and a plate or tube-type belay device.

Items 1 – 5 are mandatory. Items 6 and 7 are strongly recommended.

After registering, candidates will receive e-mail with more instructions. Sessions held spring and fall with minimum of 4 candidates.
