my.Scouting Tools is the resource for Key 3 unit leaders to get up to date a Youth Protection Aging Report. A report had been enclosed in the 2015 charter materials package but additional updates may be obtained using this tool. To access the training tools, just sign into your account at MyScouting.org and again into the *my.Scouting* log in and use the drop down to select the Training tool.

All leaders must have current Youth Protection training as of 1/1/2015. If their training has expired they will not be included on the charter. Training can be done online at MyScouting.org or in person at trainings offered year round. Please visit youthprotection.ppbsa.org to view summer and fall training dates. Or contact your district Youth Protection chair to schedule training for your unit. Youth Protection Training is important in keeping our youth safe. Please encourage leaders with training expiring in 2015 to take the training before the end of 2014 so that all leaders in your unit will have current youth protection training for 2015. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Visit www.myscouting.org. 2. Sign in or create an account. 3. Choose Patriots' Path Council #358 as your council. 4. Please include your membership number in your profile. 5. Select E-learning from the left sidebar. 6. Scroll down and select Take Course next to Youth Protection. 7. Keep a copy of your certificate for your records. You may be asked to provide it in the future. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Visit www.myscouting.org. 2. Click create an account. Enter a user name. Select I am new and don't know my number. Fill in the form. Check your email for a link to verify your email. 3. Select a password. 4. Sign in with the user name and password just created. 5. Select E-Learning on left side bar. 6. Scroll down and select Take Course for Youth Protection. 7. When finished, print your personalized certificate and attach to your BSA application.

Note: **Venturing Leaders:** if you are registered in Venturing, select the Venturing Tab as you must complete the Youth Protection Training – Venture version.
