



# Chartered Organization Representative Training



“In territory supervised by local councils, each chartered organization shall appoint a volunteer, other than the unit leader or assistant unit leader, as its **chartered organization representative** to represent it as a member of the district committee and as a voting member of the local council.”

As a chartered organization representative, you hold a key position in Scouting.

This training will help you understand:

- 1) The mission, purpose and structure of the BSA.
- 2) The responsibilities of the chartered organization.
- 3) The responsibilities of the BSA.
- 4) Understand the chartered organization representative's (COR) relationship to their unit, chartered organization and council.
- 5) Understand the specific tasks of a COR.
- 6) Become familiar with the resources to do the task.
