We hope you and a guest will join us for an exciting weekend getaway at the 24th World Scout Jamboree at the BSA's premier high adventure base, the Summit Bechtel Reserve!

A World Jamboree in the USA is a once-in-a-generation event. The 24th WSJ will be the first one held in North America in 36 years (1983 Alberta, Canada) and the first in the United States in 52 years (1967, Idaho). It's an opportunity for Scouters to get engaged with the global Scouting community. While Scouting is a worldwide movement, the program is slightly different in each country based on their history, cultures and customs, but we are all united through the world brotherhood of Scouting.

It's a weekend for friendship, fellowship and adventure! The focus at WSJ is more on meeting people from different cultures and countries and has unique programs for participants to learn about different cultures, sustainability, peace and community service.

Bus transportation departing Friday and returning on Sunday is available on a first come first served basis.

The trip includes bus transportation, rooming and a VIP package to the World Scout Jamboree.

The cost for a single is \$680 per person or double occupancy \$475 per person.
